#### Location:

#### **Eligibility & Standards:**

All artists who create quality art and crafts of original concept and execution are welcome. The use of commercial kits, purchased items, or direct sales items is prohibited.

#### **Jurying Policy:**

All applicants must enclose (or e-mail to mjknapp@milwaukeehistory.net) 4 current pictures, 3 depicting your work and one of your booth set-up, which will be evaluated for craftsmanship, originality, and design. Photographs will be used to verify design and quality for acceptance into the show, so it is important that they accurately represent your work.

Photos will not be returned.

#### **Application procedure:**

Complete the Harvest of Art & Crafts Application as well as a Wisconsin Sellers permit. The Milwaukee County Historical Society must forward tax information to the State for all exhibitors.

Note: Birthdate and driver's license are required per Village of Greendale Statute.

- For registration postmarked by March 31<sup>st</sup>, early fees are:

  - \$150 Outdoor Booth for Returning Exhibitors
  - \$180 Premier Outdoor booth + Parking
  - \$85 Indoor Mini Booth
  - \$170 Indoor Booth
  - \$185 Premier Indoor Booth Booths 95P,113P, 114P Stone Barn, Machine Shed, & Red Barn)
  - \$30 Overnight Trailer Parking— see appl. for rules
- For registration starting April 1st until June 30th regular fees are:
  - \$160 Outdoor Booth
  - \$ 200 Premier Outdoor Booth + Parking
  - \$100 Indoor Mini Booth
  - \$180 Indoor Booth
  - \$195 Premier Indoor Booth (Stone Barn,
  - Machine Shed, and Red Barn)
  - \$40 Overnight Trailer Parking—see appl. for rules

For registration **starting July 1st Late fees are:**\$200 outdoor booth
\$50 Overnight trailer parking see appl. for rules

- Completed WI Sellers permit.
- ◆ Three (3) photos of your work and one (1) of your booth set-up. E-mailed photos are preferred.

#### **Additional Information:**

- 1. The Harvest of Art & Crafts is MCHS's largest fundraiser of the year and we work hard to make it a success for all.
- 2. Each outdoor booth space is approximately 11' by 11'. A half booth is approximately 5' by 10'. **Please go to: trimbornfarm.com** for specific information and booth photos.
- 3. MCHS will hold the first round of checks until **the week of April 10th.** . <u>Once accepted, the fee is non-refundable.</u>
- 4. The first round of acceptance notifications will be sent via e-mail by April 20th.
- 5. Exhibitors will receive space allocations and additional directions in early August.
- 6. **We try to accommodate space requests but cannot guarantee them.** Returning exhibitors registered by **March 31st** will have first preference depending on availability.
- 7. Raffle: We ask each artist to donate an item for our raffle. This year, the exhibitor whose item has the most tickets at the time of the raffle drawing (Sunday afternoon) will win a FREE registration fee to Harvest 2023 (\$150 value)!
- 8. Set-up will be from **2-7pm** on Friday September 8th, and 7-9:30am Saturday & Sunday. Camping is not allowed on the grounds.
- 9. Artists with trailers will need to schedule their arrival with Mary Jo Knapp. See application.
- 10. Exhibitors receive all proceeds from sales and are responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax.
